The City of Brighton and the Brighton Downtown Development Authority partnered with Ann Arbor SPARK to attract, grow, and retain Main Street businesses in the downtown area. Most notably, the team developed the Main Street Showcase mobile app to create a unified platform for marketing, advertising, promotion, and communication across the DDA area.

Since 2015, FT Techno of America (FTTA) has

operated an automotive vehicle evaluation center on proving grounds spanning approximately 950 acres in Handy Township. In 2021, FTTA invested in an expansion, constructing a 1.4 mile handling course, as well as an area of special surfaces for evaluating vehicle ride comfort, noise, harshness, and vibration.

A joint effort between SPARK and the **Greater Area Brighton Chamber of Commerce**, the *Manufacturing Collaborative* is a group of nine employers that meet regularly to share data and ideas to create a pipeline of talent for critical jobs

in the county. Last year, the program expanded when Brighton-based **Work Skills**Corporation created a curriculum using virtual reality and computer-based online training methods to expedite workforce training for skilled trades positions.
